Next year will be an exciting and challenging year. To keep students' math skills sharp, you will find a packet of review problems for each grade level that students should complete over the summer. The packet will be collected when we return to school and graded for completion.

Incoming 8th grade students will also have optional IXL skills to help prepare them for the HSPT test they will take in the winter. The skills are not divided by Drexel or Xavier but instead by the two main math sections, Quantitative and Mathematics. Again, the IXL set is completely optional and is meant to help students practice important HSPT skills.

We also encourage your child to pace themselves. *Don't wait until August to complete the packets!* Using a calendar to map out the skills and when to complete them is a strong strategy and great way to stay organized!
