Grades 4-5 Summer IXL Math Work 2024-2025

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Over the summer, we want to make sure students are practicing the skills they learned last year so they are ready for the 2024-2025 school year when they return to school in September!

Next year will be an exciting and challenging year. To keep students' math skills sharp, you will find a number of IXL skills attached, which they should practice over the summer. We ask that each student completes the 20 skills, 10 from this past grade level to review, and 10 skills from their incoming grade level to preview and prepare as they enter the new school year. Students must either spend 20 minutes working on the skill or reach 100% (whichever comes first). If a certain skill is too challenging, please make a note on the log and move onto the next skill. Can you do more than the listed skills? Of course! We have even given you blank spaces at the end of the chart to list any other skills that you completed that were not included on this sheet.

Encourage your child to pace themself. <u>Don't wait until August to complete</u> <u>these skills!</u> If students do 2-3 skills a week, then they should be able to complete the whole list before the start of school. If you know you are going on vacation over the summer, students may want to try to do 4-5 skills each week for the weeks you are at home. Using a calendar to map out the skills and when to complete them is a strong strategy and great way to stay organized!

Each student is asked to complete and return the IXL Math Log to his/her math teacher in the fall when we return to school, which will be the first math grade entered for the trimester.
