Over the summer, we want to make sure students are practicing the skills they learned last year so they are ready for the 2024-2025 school year when they return to school in September!

Next year will be an exciting and challenging year. To keep students' math skills sharp, you will find a list of assignments for each grade level that students should complete over the summer. The assignments will be collected when we return to school and graded for completion.

Incoming 6th grade students will complete the online google forms, weekly work. All work can be found in the google classroom. IXL skills are optional and can be used to best support your scholar.

Incoming 7Drexel students will log into their google classroom and complete the google forms. Complete the IXL skills as you wish, but they are not summer work mandatory.

Incoming 7Xavier along with incoming 8th grade students will complete a set of online skills through DeltaMath that will be essential for students to master in order to be successful in their respective Algebra 1 courses. Students will be tested on all of these skills when we return to school.

Incoming 8th grade students will <u>also</u> have optional IXL skills to help prepare them for the HSPT test they will take in the winter. The skills are not divided by Drexel or Xavier but instead by the two main math sections, Quantitative and Mathematics. Again, the IXL set is completely optional and is meant to help students practice important HSPT skills.

We also encourage your child to pace themself. <u>Don't wait until August to complete the work!</u> Using a calendar to map out the skills and when to complete them is a strong strategy and great way to stay organized!
